## **CREATE YOUR OWN XERIC CRITTER PLANTER**

Planter Workshop at the Halawa Xeriscape Garden

- WHAT: Create custom made critter planters! A hands-on workshop offered by the Board of Water Supply (BWS) and Friends of Halawa Xeriscape Garden (FOHXG) will show you how to create a xeric critter planter out of a recycled 2-liter bottle.
- WHEN: Saturday, February 13, 2016 10:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

- **DETAILS:** This hands-on workshop involves crafting a 2-liter plastic bottle to look like a hedgehog or other outdoor critter. With an ounce of creativity, participants can fashion recycled containers that are practical, fun to use in your garden and simple to create. You will also learn a few hints on how to care for your container plants. Potted plants tend to require more water than in-ground plants, so using drought tolerant plants is a great way to conserve water outdoors. You will also learn to shop for and identify drought tolerant plants.
- **COST:** \$7 for non-members; \$2 for members of the FOHXG (depending on level of membership).
