**DETAILS:** Hypertufa is an artificial material mixture of Portland cement, perlite and

sphagnum moss that is moldable and cures over time. Hypertufa cast resembles natural stone, however its composition is much more lightweight and permeable,

allowing for more creative and textured moldings.

This hands-on workshop involves mixing and molding your own hypertufa

pot. With an ounce of creativity, participants can fashion artful containers that are

practical in the garden and simple to create.
