



CONTROLLED WATER LEVEL REDUCTION SCHEDULED FOR NUUANU RESERVOIR No. 4

The Board of Water Supply (BWS) is working to rehabilitate the Nuuanu Reservoir No. 4 dam, which is located on protected watershed land off of Pali Highway, above Nuuanu Pali Drive. This project requires crews to gain access to the lower levels of the dam structure by lowering the water level in the reservoir. To do so crews will be slowly draining water at low flows from the reservoir into Nuuanu Stream.

When this occurs, residents may notice changes in flow of Nuuanu Stream, with water levels or stream flows either rising or falling. This is considered a normal part of planned maintenance and dam rehabilitation work, and is not cause for concern.

• Anticipated start of work is February 6, 2019.

- Actual work dates and project duration are subject to change dependent on weather and other construction delays.
